

ATTACHMENT A

Authorized Personal Protective Clothing and Equipment (PPE)

All purchases of these types of items will be in accordance with requirements referenced within the departments safety manual Chapter 8.1

- Coveralls¹ – (color optional by supervisor's approval)
- High visibility raingear (flaggers and others who may be working in/on/near hazardous locations)
- Rain Gear (coats and bibs) for pressure washing, etc.
- High visibility reflective clothing meeting ANSI standards (flaggers and others who may be working in/on/near hazardous locations)
- Hard hats and liners/bump caps
- Hearing protection
- Safety glasses
- Safety goggles and face shields
- Orange knit hats
- Work gloves
- Hip boots/chest waders
- Overshoe impact clip on and gripping sole attachment devices
- PFDs/Mustang suits, float coats, life jackets
- Protective gear for chain saw– chaps, hardhat w/visor
- Protective gear for welding and arc flash fire retardant clothing (welding jackets, overalls, shirts and gloves)
- Chemical gloves – as required for handling chemicals and petroleum products
- Lab coats
- Aprons to handle hazardous liquids
- Respirators in conjunction with all safety manual requirements
- Helmets (Full-face only) – snow machines & four-wheelers
- Fall protection restraint systems components
- Prescription eyewear inserts/lenses for full face respirators
- Prescription eyewear inserts/lenses for welding and diving helmets

Not allowed:

- Arctic cold weather gear including parkas, insulated pants, cold weather boots, mittens, etc.
- Impact or slip resistant shoes or boot of any kind. (If clip-on devices do not provide adequate protection, exceptions may be requested from the DOT&PF Administrative Services Division (ASD) director on a case-by-case basis.)
- Personal use of any authorized PPE. If any PPE leaves the worksite, the supervisor must have an agreement with the employee that addresses the return, loss and replacement.
- A clothing allowance that permits an employee to purchase personal protective clothing on an "as needed" basis.

¹ Substitution of brown duck non-insulated bib overalls (at a similar cost) may be approved by supervisor.

Note: No other PPE will be considered without a job safety/hazards analysis attached.
